



Pennsylvania District 22 Policy Statement

Subject; **Official Little League Patches**

Effective Date – **12/10/2008**

The Little League Baseball/Softball “Official Regulations and Playing Rules” for all divisions of play in Regulation I(c)6. in part states the following;

“(The Official Little League Shoulder Patch must be affixed to the upper left sleeve of the uniform blouse in all divisions of play.)”.

Adherence to this Regulation in full as well as all other Regulations and Rules contained in the “Official Regulations and Playing Rules” are a condition of Charter for local Little Leagues.

It is the District Administrators responsibility to assist the local Little League in their compliance with all “Official Regulations and Playing Rules”. Additionally, it is the District Administrators duty to make value judgments concerning them.

Regular season play or interleague play games shall not be halted or delayed because of the lack of the team(s) involved meeting the requirements of wearing Little League Patches.

District 22 Staff Volunteer Umpires shall umpire the games assigned and if a team(s) are in violation of Regulation I(c)6. it should be so noted and reported to the District Administrator. The District Administrator shall work with the league(s) with the goal being to correct the situation.

District 22 Tournament games shall be handled as they always have been, namely the game official(s) shall report all violations of this Regulation to the District Administrator and/or the Tournament Administrator who will have the matter settled through the East Region Headquarters of Little League Baseball/Softball.
